Frequently asked questions

How do I apply for a stall at Young Blood?

To apply for a stall visit www.powerhousemuseum.com/youngblood/ and download an application form.

When and where is Young Blood held?

The designers market is held at the Powerhouse Museum on Friday 14 August, 6.00–9.00 pm; Saturday 15 August, 10.00 am – 5.00 pm.

Do I have to trade on all days?

Yes the stall fee covers all days of trading and stallholders are required to be onsite and trading for the duration of the market.

When is the closing date for applications?

Applications close on Friday 26 June 2009.

When will I be notified if I am successful in gaining a stall?

Stallholders will be notified by Friday 3 July 2009.

What happens to my products overnight?

The market is located in a secure and lockable area of the Museum. Stallholders will be able to leave their products overnight. The Museum has on site security 24 hours a day.

How much is a single stall?

A single stall is \$330.00 incl. gst.

What will be provided for stallholders?

A standard trestle table approx 1.8m (L) x 0.75m (W) x 0.94m (H).

What do I do next if my application is successful?

You will be contacted and provided with details regarding the registration process, payment of fees and insurance requirements. You will also be asked to provide details of any signage and/or display material that you may wish to use.

When can I set up and pack down my stall?

You will be notified by the **Young Blood** coordinator about this process.

Can I park my car at the Museum?

On site parking at the Powerhouse Museum is up to the discretion of the Powerhouse Museum. There will be a designated point for your vehicle for unloading and loading your merchandise. The Entertainment Centre located at the rear of the Museum offers a special discounted fee.

What if I need a break from staffing my stall?

The markets are very busy with little opportunity to leave your stall unattended. It is recommended that you make arrangements for someone to relieve you for breaks.

Do I need Public Liability Insurance?

\$10 million Public Liability Insurance for conducting business outside of normal premises is compulsory for all stallholders. A certificate of currency must be attached to your registration form. If you do not have your own Insurance the Museum can arrange cover for you from an approved Insurance Broker for an additional fee of \$80.00 per stall.

Are there credit card, EFTPOS or banking facilities available?

None of these facilities will be provided by the Museum. Ensure that you have made adequate provision for change on the day. Should you wish to use credit card or EFTPOS contact your bank to discuss various services the bank provides.

What if it rains?

Young Blood will trade in wet weather however the Museum reserves the right to cancel the market should it deem the conditions too dangerous.

What if I cancel my application?

Cancellations by stallholders after registration will be charged full stall rental.

Will there be food and drink available?

Yes both food and drink will be available for purchase.
