Powerhouse Museum remembers king of pop

The Powerhouse Museum is commemorating the passing of king of pop Michael Jackson with a small display of memorabilia as well as a visitor condolence book.

The display features memorabilia from the Museum's collection including an official tour jacket from Jackson's *Bad* world tour, a Michael Jackson miniature doll, swap cards and the *Thriller* album cover.

The small display will be accompanied by a condolence book where visitors to the Museum can record their thoughts and memories of this worldwide pop culture icon.

"Michael Jackson was a brilliant musician and performer, whose music, dancing and style influenced a generation through the 1980s and, to this day, still have resonance," said Powerhouse Museum curator Peter Cox.

Jackson will also be remembered as part of an exhibition celebrating the 80s era currently being developed by the Powerhouse Museum and scheduled to open in December 2009.
